

80% of servicing is due to wrong installation or use ...



#### **Examples ...**


- **♦** Foreign object blocks pipes
- **♦** Head is too high for product
- **♦** Fitting of wrong inlet our outlet connectors
- **O** Smell





Always connect from the top.


Otherwise, drainage water will block Saniflo sewage line.



Saniflo to have its own discharge line. Waste could discharge through washbasin line.

Risk of smell.





Always try vertical discharge as pump force is most powerful at the start.




Use long radius bends 2 x 45° vs. 1 x 90°

Install the unit on the same level as your toilet and not more than 45 cm (17 inches) from exit of WC.



To avoid siphoning, install air admittance valve when pumping lower than the unit.





If not, increase discharge pipe size in the vertical drop.





Wye fitting on the discharge line to facilitate drainage of vertical pipe.



Only throw toilet paper in WC.
